## **Confirmation Camp Policy**

*“With all humility and gentleness, with patience, bearing with one another in love, making every effort to maintain the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace. There is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called to the one hope of your calling, one Lord, one faith, one baptism, one God and Father of all, who is above all and through all and in all.”*

The purpose of confirmation camp is to:

- Discuss and explore matters of confirmation;
- Develop leaders for the Church and the world;
- For all participants (adults and youth) to strengthen their faith lives;
- All while being “camper first” at all times.

St. Peter Confirmation Camp has been a tradition since 1974. In an effort to maintain and honor this tradition it is necessary to put in writing some camp policies to reinforce the structure of camp while maintaining the spirit of the tradition of camp:

- The Pastor and Youth Director of St. Peter Lutheran Church will be the camp directors.
- Adult staff will be those one year out of high school and older. (Junior Staff will be those who have been confirmed who are still in high school.)
- In order to meet our purpose of confirmation camp, it is required that all Adult Staff have a continued relationship with their home congregation through regular attendance and participation.
- All adults will follow St. Peter Safe Child Policy and Nawakwa Rules (as updated by St. Peter Lutheran Church and the Camping Corporation).
